

Re: Generator Installations

There has been an increase in the installation of natural gas generators in our service territory. Because of the significant load requirements of generators, in most cases, the existing service line will be inadequate. Therefore, prior to installing a new generator in a home, please contact us at 927-4328, so that we can determine if a new line will be required. We will need the load information for all natural gas appliances in the home. Because of the minimal usage of this type of appliance, it is likely that any upgrade to the meter and/or service will result in a charge to the homeowner for the cost of time and materials. Thus, it is vital that you get this information prior to sale/installation so that it can be included in the total quote for the generator and avoid any unexpected charges for your customers.
