Pump Installer Licensing & Continuing Education Law Recently Passed

The primary objective of this legislation is to protect the groundwater resource. The Indiana Department of Natural Resources, Division of Water, will serve as the regulatory body for this license. Each licensed driller will be notified by the DNR regarding a public meeting, date to be determined. Anyone who installs a water well pump must be licensed; in the past this was not the case. Many individuals were installing pumps without the proper licensing. All water well drilling contractors are licensed for pump installation systems.

There will be many opportunities to acquire the 6 hours of continuing education required every 2 years through the IGWA, in addition to various state and national organizations. If you have any questions, please contact the IGWA office at 888-443-7330 or email them at ingroundwater@msn.com.
