Growing Our Membership

In 2008 when we received the Chapter Excellence Award from National PHCC, GIPHCC could boast a membership of **100** contractor and associate members. Currently in 2011, we have a membership of **79** members—even counting our newest associate, Wilds Restoration Services (see p. 2, News of Note). This number is 35 contractor members and 44 associate members.


