OSHA 10 Hour Class

IAPHCC, Mechanical Skills, and Bailey Safety Group will present the OSHA 10 Hour General Industry Course. The class is scheduled on 2 consecutive Wednesdays in October, the 12and and 19th, from 1-6 pm, at Mechanical Skills. You <u>must</u> attend both classes in order to complete the course.

Participants will receive useful reference materials, a copy of the Standards, and a certificate of completion. Course topics include the following: introduction to OSHA standards, walking and working surfaces, materials handling, hazardous materials, materials storage, machine guarding, electrical safety, toxic and hazardous materials, and much more.

The class will be taught by Jon Hile, Safety Director for Bailey Safety Group. Cost will be \$130 each for PHCC & Mechanical Skills Members; \$175 each for non-members. The registration forms are available on www.iaphcc.com or by contacting IAPHCC, 575-9292.

32 Hour Med Gas Class

IAPHCC is partnering with Mechanical Skills and GasMedix to provide a 32 hour Medical Gas System, ASSE 6010 Class for Installer Certification & Brazing Qualification. The class will be held on November 7-11 at Mechanical Skills.


Successful completion of the required 32 hour course requires a passing grade of 75% on a written exam given on the morning of the 5th day and brazing of a coupon in both the horizontal and vertical positions.

Applicants wishing to attend this class must have a minimum of 4 years of documented practical experience in the installation of piping systems. Attendees must provide documented proof (such as a letter from a current and/or previous employer) along with a photo ID before they can take the final exams.

This course is provided by GasMedix LLC. The course will be conducted by an ASSE 6050 Medical Pipeline Instructor with over 33 years' experience in the medical gas industry that includes service, engineering & training, BSEE, BSEM, and CMGV. A syllabus will be provided. A copy of the NFPA 99, 2005 edition will be provided for each attendee.

Attendees must bring 3-4 feet of clean, 1.5" type L, B-819 copper tubing, 4-6, 1.5 inch type L couplings (no slip couplings), no fewer than 8 rods of BCuP filler (recommend 15% silver for the best results), and a photo ID.

Cost for the class will be \$900 each for PHCC & Mechanical Skills members; \$1200 each for non-members. The registration forms are available on www.iaphcc.com or by contacting IAPHCC, 575-9292..
